Bappeda Mimika Holds Public Consultation Meeting on Second Draft of the Regional Action Plan for Sustainable Development Goals for the 2020-2024 Period

(Timika) Mimika Regency's Development Planning, Research and Development Agency (Bappeda) held a public consultation meeting on drawing up an action plan for the region to accelerate achievement of sustainable development goals (SDGs). This event took place at Hotel Cartenz, Timika, on Monday (21/3/2022), with Mimika Regency 1st Assistant Secretary Yulianus Sasarari, S.Sos, M.Si in attendance. Also present were Mimika Regency government agency ranks, and representatives from NGOs, higher education institutions, media organizations, and PT Freeport Indonesia (PTFI).

The meeting follows up on a previous one in which a team or work group had been formed consisting of elements from Mimika Regency government agencies, PTFI, and Amungme and Kamoro Community Empowerment Foundation YPMAC. Sasarari stated the main objective of today's meeting was to deliver a second draft of the Mimika Regency SDGs Action Plan for the 2020-2024 period and to seek feedback from the regency's working partners.

In delivering an address from Mimika's Regent, Sasarari stated SDGs are a global as well as national commitment aimed at resolving issues related to poverty and food, improving the quality of economic growth and basic services, eliminating interregional disparities, affording access to justice, improving environmental quality, and bringing about inclusive development through participative planning and implementation processes.

"The Mimika Regency government is committed to implementing development under the SDGs framework. In principle, SDGs align with Mimika Regency's development vision as set out in the regency's medium term development plan (RPJMD) for the 2022-2024 period, namely Realizing a Safe, Peaceful and Prosperous Mimika," Sasarari said.

Regent's Decree (SK) Number 205 of 2021 concerning establishment of a SDGs Team is pursuant to Presidential mandate number 59 of 2017 concerning achievement of SDGs and is part of execution of the RPJMD.

Mimika Regency Head of Bappeda, Ir. Yohana Paliling, M.Si said the agency has high hopes of participation from non-government agencies. "The regional action plan (RAD) that will be agreed in the augmentation meeting will become the reference for execution of programs to accelerate achievement of SDGs in Mimika Regency," Yohana said.

In Mimika, the regency government in conjunction with PT Freeport Indonesia and YPMAC, which are representing non-government actors, continue the collaboration to bring to bear 4 target SDGs pillars and goals, namely Social Development, Economic Development, Environmental

Development, and Legal and Governance Development. Other non-government actors, from the private sector, nonprofit organizations, faith-based organizations, and educational institutions, are expected to engage in concert in supporting achievement of SDGs in Mimika Regency.
